HOW YOU CAN HELP

1. Educate

Individuals are encouraged to educate themselves, and then others, on:

- Healthy child development as an effective means to preventing child abuse and neglect from ever happening in the first place
- The programs and services offered in the community and making sure they are available and accessible to families
- The ways they can bring Pinwheels for Prevention to their community

2. Participate

Individuals are encouraged to:

- Volunteer for and/or donate their professional expertise to local agencies working with children or to Prevent Child Abuse Florida
- Serve on a local or national committee or board
- Help get the word out by disseminating the campaign messaging via their "channels", such as their blogs or Facebook pages, or in their children's schools, community organizations or religious institutions to which they belong
- Subscribe to the Prevent Child Abuse Florida e-newsletter to stay informed

3. Advocate

Individuals are encouraged to:
