

### Scorecard Measure 7 – Children Who Do Not Re-Enter Care









### **Exit Interview Timeliness by CMO**

HFC Cumulative YTD Timeliness: 58.50%












### **Exit Interviews Trending by CMO**

HFC Cumulative YTD Timeliness: 58.50%










### **Adoption Finalizations**







HFC – DCF Circuit 10 Number of Missing Youth as of Reporting Date









Number of Dental Visits to Achieve SM10 Target - Achieved






