Helping Families Succeed (HFS) provides services to families in Hardee, Highland and Polk counties that include assessment of mental health needs and continued supportive counseling for parents. Help with employment and financial preparedness, as well as parenting interventions, is also available. HFS services are designed to offer ongoing support and are available in the home on a weekly basis. The program may be able to help with these issues:

- Anger management
- Domestic violence
- Education
- Employment
- Mental health/
 Postpartum depression
- Relationship problems

To be eligible:

- A referral must be submitted to the HFS program for pre-screening.
- The individual must have legal custody of a child under the age of 18.
- Individual/Family income level should meet TANF eligibility (below 200 percent federal poverty level).
